1	<p>The Head of Healthcare should ensure that, where cardiovascular risk factors are identified at reception screens, consideration is given to reviewing to previous notes and blood test results so that any abnormalities can be addressed; management plans must be documented in the healthcare notes.</p>	Accepted	<p>The healthcare provider in place at the time of Mr Smith’s death has been replaced with a new provider.</p> <p>There is an embedded process that staff are required to follow. This requires staff to consider reviewing previous notes/blood test results where cardiovascular factors are identified at the reception screens. All staff will however be reminded of this, in March 2021 through a briefing and in supervisions carried out by the clinical nurse manager.</p> <p>More generally, the existing healthcare provider has carried out a review of the Long Term Conditions processes. The review was completed in February 2021 and the report is now due for wider consideration and implementation; it also addresses the concerns set out in this recommendation.</p> <p>From February 2021, management plans will be documented in healthcare notes. They will capture the content of discussion and advice given more explicitly i.e. diet and support to stop smoking and signposting to services, such as smoking cessation, gym referral, NHS health checks and when these checks are due.</p>	<p>March 2021</p> <p>Head of Healthcare</p>
