1	<p>The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that staff manage prisoners at risk of suicide and self-harm in line with national guidelines. In particular they should ensure that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • staff understand the procedures for identifying, managing and supporting prisoners at risk of suicide and self-harm; • staff assess the risk of suicide and self-harm based on all available information and known risk factors and not on a prisoner's own presentation; and • staff understand the need to share all relevant information about risk. 		<p>Suicide and Self-Harm (SASH) training is mandatory for all staff and includes training on identifying risk factors of new prisoners and determining risk of self-harm or suicide. All staff will complete this training by 2019, as part of a national programme</p> <p>The Governor of HMP Dartmoor and the Safer Custody team are facilitating monthly awareness sessions in SASH from October 2017 until January 2018 for all prisoner-facing staff so that they are aware of the need to consider and record risk factors of prisoners who may be vulnerable to self-harm or suicide and that they should not rely solely on the presentation of the prisoner.</p> <p>In September 2017 Healthcare implemented weekly multi-meetings to discuss those prisoners at risk of suicide and self-harm, review their cases and brief the Safer Custody Team on relevant information about risk and on the appropriate action to take where necessary.</p>	Head of Safety Completed
