1	<p>The Governor should ensure that all staff undertaking risk assessments for prisoners taken to hospital understand the legal position on the use of restraints, and that assessments fully take into account the health of a prisoner and are based on the actual risk a prisoner presents at the time.</p>	Accepted	<p>The Head of Security and in their absence the Deputy Governor or Governor sign off all risk assessments for hospital escort/bed watches other than out of hours emergency escorts; their risk assessments will fully take into account the health of the prisoner and the risks presented at the time.</p> <p>Escort risk assessment and bed watch documentation now make clear reference to the Graham and Daly judgements and require staff to remain aware of their responsibilities and contact the establishment should there be any changes to medical presentation. This information forms part of the pre-escort briefing carried out by the security team.</p> <p>A Governor’s Order has been issued to all staff (November 2020) that sets out clear instructions about the legal position. Further, daily management checks are being completed on every bed watch with the management check sheet including specific considerations around the Graham judgement. The management checks are completed by a Custodial Manager for Category B prisoners and an Operational Manager checks Category A prisoners.</p>	<p>Complete Governor</p>
