1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that 'reverse-cohorting' is consistently applied to all prisoners returning from a hospital stay.	Accepted	All prisoners should be reverse cohorted following a stay overnight in hospital for 14 days in line with guidance. A Notice to Residents was issued in May 2021 to reiterate that those returning from hospital will be isolated for this length of time.	Complete  Head of Safety
2	The Governor should ensure that staff notify a prisoner's next of kin as soon as possible when a prisoner becomes seriously ill.	Accepted	All Duty Governors were reminded about the importance of contacting a prisoner's next of kin when a prisoner is admitted to hospital seriously unwell and that Safer Custody are informed to ensure that a FLO can be allocated promptly. This reminder was sent by email to all Duty Governor in April 2021.	Complete  Head of Safety
