1	The Heads of Healthcare at HMP Leeds and HMP Wakefield should ensure that their screening procedures include embedded elements to capture and record the learning disabilities of prisoners with a pre-existing diagnosis.	Accepted	<p><b>HMP Leeds</b></p> <p>Diagnosis of a Learning Disability from Reception is self-reported. HMP Leeds in in tranche 4 of the roll out of GP2GP SystemOne care records summary which will assist Healthcare teams to confirm such a diagnosis. HMP Leeds employ a Learning Disabilities Nurse within the Mental Health team currently. The role of the LD nurse is to ensure that interventions are targeted and specific to the degree of identified/ Learning Disability and to liaise with partners for patient specific assistance.</p> <p><b>HMP Wakefield</b></p> <p>Diagnosis of Learning disability is captured through reception screening. Equally the team are currently working on an early day's project which will see them take a deep dive into patient's records. This will be enhanced by the roll out of the GP2GP framework which will allow prison team access to patient's medical records from community also.
