Once a referral is made Amey will contact the external company and they will attend to assess the fault. This will be repaired at the earliest opportunity</p>	Amey/Head of Security	September 2021
2	The Governor should ensure that roll checks are properly carried out and that staff understand their responsibilities to check there are no immediate issues that need attention.	Accepted	A notice to staff will be published to remind all staff of their responsibilities when completing roll checks (particular during the night state), that they must satisfy themselves that all prisoners are present and correctly accounted for, and where there are concerns around the prisoner's well-being, staff should try to get a response or gesture from the prisoner.
