2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that healthcare contributions to escort risk assessments are accurate, sufficiently detailed and reflect the prisoner's current clinical condition.	Accepted	This is a repeated recommendation. There has been previous training regarding the Graham Judgment and an audit carried out. The audit showed that staff require further education regarding inputting patients' medication presentation. The audit and training were carried out in May 2021. The training regarding the Graham Judgement will be cascaded to new members of staff.	Head of Healthcare	Complete

Where medical in confidence issues permit, health care staff will provide information of any serious medical condition and mobility which would limit an individual's risk to the public and risk of escape.</p> <p>Also, the correct use of the Graham Judgement was discussed at an education session to healthcare staff.</p> <p>The requirement of the Graham judgement, that authorising managers must take account of the health/mobility of the prisoner at the time has been implemented.</p>	Head of Security	Complete
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
