1	The Director should identify and address the key weaknesses in reducing the supply of drugs at Parc and revise the Drug Strategy Policy in light of the findings.	Accepted	<p>The HMPPS 'Drug Diagnostic Self-assessment Tool' has been completed to identify actions and priorities to be taken across drug strategy services. We have also fully reviewed our substance misuse recovery provision including our Psychoactive Substances (PS) approach, and subsequently implemented a 'Psychoactive Substance Rapid Response Service (PSRRS).</p> <p>Feedback from the self-assessment and our review of recovery services will be incorporated into our revised drug strategy policy, which will be in place by October 2019. The new substance misuse draft policy has been revised and is currently with the Director for approval.</p>	<p>October 2019</p> <p>Senior Manager Substance Misuse</p>
2	The Director and Head of Healthcare should take steps to develop a more integrated and bespoke substance misuse treatment service for prisoners who use psychoactive substances.	Accepted	Daily clinics have been introduced for those prisoners who use psychoactive substances with effect from August 2019. Prisoners accessing these clinics will receive a comprehensive health assessment. If any health concerns are identified a care plan will be implemented by the clinician to address these concerns. Prisoners will have immediate access to rescue medication should they be experiencing any withdrawal symptoms. Prisoners will be signposted to other specialities should a need be identified via the health assessment.	<p>Complete</p> <p>Head of Healthcare</p>
3	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that healthcare staff fully document health screens, reviews and care plans.	Accepted	<p>All nurses have been reminded via email in September 2019 of their responsibility to ensure that they fully document health screens, reviews and care plans.</p> <p>All new staff will receive training during induction on the importance of accurate and thorough documentation when completing health screens, reviews and care plans. This will be monitored by Healthcare managers as part of their weekly audits and compliance checks.</p>	<p>Complete</p> <p>Head of Healthcare</p>
4	The Director should ensure that all control room staff call an ambulance as soon as an emergency code is called.	Accepted	A Director's order was issued to all staff in September 2019 instructing that the ambulance service be contacted immediately on an emergency medical code being called.
