| 1 | The Head of Healthcare should ensure that reception screening staff make all reasonable attempts to obtain past healthcare records, including the Summary Care Record, and that these are used to obtain information about the prisoner's previous medical history. | Accepted | The summary care record (SCR) is available at the reception screening for review and evaluation. During this detailed assessment, information is gathered to ensure first night safety is secured within an expedient timeframe. If the clinicians cannot conduct a full review of the SCR at reception it is evaluated in full the next day for clinical risk, for medication and any other pertinent information. This is done at the earliest possible opportunity to ensure safety. | Complete Head of Healthcare |
| 2 | The Head of Healthcare should ensure that a secondary health screen is offered to all newly arrived prisoners. | Accepted | There is a system in place which reminds nursing staff of the need to complete a secondary health screen every time notes are opened until complete. All staff were reminded in July 2021 of the need to complete as quickly as possible. | Complete Head of Healthcare |
| 3 | The Head of Healthcare should ensure that requests by prisoners not to be resuscitated are discussed and implemented without delay. | Accepted | A review was undertaken in July 2021 with prison GPs to check the process for completing a DNACPR, with the objective being no delays in creation of the required documentation and avoidance of potential unacceptable interventions taking place. | Complete Head of Healthcare |
