Accepted	<p>The Head of Healthcare will ensure that as a matter of course all offenders returning from hospital following an acute episode are seen by healthcare staff.</p> <p>A joint protocol with the Governor will be agreed and published.</p> <p>In the event of an offender returning to prison out of hours, they will be seen at the earliest opportunity.</p> <p>An assessment will be made and care plan initiated for ongoing reviews as necessary.
