1	The Governor should ensure that the key drug issues at Guy's Marsh are identified and that the prison's local drugs strategy is revised by September 2019 to ensure that these key issues are being addressed.	Accepted	<p>HMP Guys Marsh have created the role of Head of Drug Strategy. This role will work in collaboration with a number of other functions as part of an all prison approach to drug issues and the connection this has with violence, bullying and self-harm.</p> <p>The drug strategy document is currently being updated to reflect data from a new needs analysis and also from drug strategy forums, prisoner surveys, and research projects. This has brought together Safer Custody, Security, Integrated Substance Misuse Services, Healthcare, Growth Project (rehabilitative culture team), residential staff, activities, and external partnership agencies including the police and community agencies. The completion of the document will go through a consultative process with other establishment functions, and also shared with union colleagues.</p> <p>A drug strategy meeting has also been created to encourage information sharing. The meetings will consider data from all functions which will support evidence based actions and priority work.</p> <p>The Local Tasking Meeting (LTM) has been created to bring together various functions and their analysts into one intelligence hub within the prison. This will create better working relationships between Safer Custody and Security functions, and also influence from the Offender Management function too. The data and information shared at this meeting will create an action orientated focus that will be shared accordingly to appropriate functions.</p>	August 2019 Security and Drug Strategy
