1	<p>The Governor should ensure that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the prison gate is in working order; and • all staff who are involved in emergency escorts are aware of what paperwork is required for an ambulance to leave the prison, including whether a gate pass is required. 	Accepted	<p>A Regulation 28 for Prevention of Future Deaths (PFD) has been responded to.</p> <p>If the mechanical systems that open and close the vehicle gate fail to work, staff are able to utilise a manual override which provides an appropriate contingency. Although the process would be slower, it would not prevent emergency vehicles entering or exiting the establishment within an acceptable timescale.</p> <p>The Local Security Strategy (LSS) was reviewed to ensure the manual override for entry and exit from the gate detailed.
