1	The Head of Healthcare should consider a program of training for all healthcare staff to ensure that Advance Care Planning is offered to prisoners who would benefit from it, to include utilising the Dying Well in Custody Charter. This will help to ensure that prisoners are able to make an informed choice when it comes to making decisions about their future care.	Accepted	All staff involved in the care planning of a patient are now aware of the advanced decision making process, this has been achieved by circulating the documentation via email, lessons learned sessions with staff of all grades and discussions at the daily staff handovers. We are able to utilise the national team for advice and guidance on this area to ensure the best patient outcome. This must be undertaken whilst the patient is deemed to have capacity in order to make an advanced decision. Patients are provided with an information booklet detailing their rights and choices prior to having to make an advanced decision.
