1	The Governor should identify and address the key weaknesses in reducing the supply of drugs at Bullingdon and revise the substance misuse strategy in light of the findings.	Accepted	<p>The drug supply and demand reduction strategy is due to be revised and reissued following the easing of the Covid-19 Exceptional Regime Management Plan (ERMP) and subsequent restrictions.</p> <p>Further measures have been implemented in the interim to continue to reduce the supply of drugs and illicit items, including the use of Rapiscan machines, already used to scan mail to prevent contaminated items entering the prison, to gather intelligence on the prevalence and distribution of illicit substances. This information is then analysed and provided to the regional search team to inform their decision-making. A successful targeted searching took place across the prison in September 2020 as a result of this intelligence.</p> <p>A body scanner was further introduced in October 2020 and has led to a significant decrease in illicit items entering the prison through reception. The introduction of searching prisoners after their initial location on the first night centre (FNC) has further contributed to this reduction.</p> <p>There is an ongoing investment to enhance the airport-style security measures in place for all staff and visitors entering the prison to prevent illicit items entering the prison.</p>	June 2021 Governor and Drug Strategy Manager

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3	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that all prisoners under the mental health caseload being managed in primary care have regular reviews of their mental health care, medication and that care plans are in place.	Accepted	<p>The Mental Health Teams are currently being integrated. This involves processes and pathways being under the 'no wrong door' approach. Both teams are to be co-located and referral processes managed together. Patients will be allocated to appropriate caseloads. Care plans will be in place for all and regular reviews of health care and medication will take place.</p> <p>A Regional Mental Health Lead has been appointed to oversee this project which is due to be completed by June 2021.</p>	June 2021 Head of Healthcare
