1	<p>The Head of Healthcare should ensure that medications are prescribed in line with safe prescribing guidelines and that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• all staff in the integrated healthcare teams can demonstrate they understand prescribing guidelines; and</li><li>• prisoners have medication reviews according to their individual needs.</li></ul>	Accepted	<p>An Internal Clinical Case Review and an Internal Learning Review were both commissioned by Practice Plus Group (PPG) and similar recommendations have arisen as part of these reviews.</p> <p>As a result, all line managers have begun to discuss prescribing guidelines with clinical team members during management supervision and clinicians have been encouraged to discuss within clinical supervision to ensure that staff have a full understanding of the requirements.</p> <p>The medication review process has also been examined with a starting focus for those with long term conditions. A monthly audit schedule has been devised to support monitoring of this. To be discussed again at the medicine management meeting.
