1	The Governor should ensure that all prison staff are made aware of and understand their responsibilities during medical emergencies. In particular, staff should use a medical emergency code as soon as there are serious concerns about the health of a prisoner to alert control room staff to call an ambulance immediately.	Accepted	A Notice to Staff (NTS) will be re-issued to remind staff of their responsibilities during a medical emergency. The NTS will make it clear that staff must call a medical emergency code immediately where there are serious concerns about a prisoner's health. This will ensure that there are no delays in calling an ambulance.	Head of Safety HMPPS	November 2021
2	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that a copy of this report is shared with all staff named in this report so they are aware of the ombudsman's findings.	Accepted	The Head of Safety has arranged for a copy of the report to be shared with those prison staff named within the report to ensure they are aware of the Ombudsman's findings.
