The Probation Service should remind staff that they need to consider an individual's risk factors when considering their risk of suicide or self harm and should not rely solely on what the individual says or how he/she presents	National	NAPT	Accepted	Nationally, Approved Premises have embedded a new two-part process to manage residents that pose a risk of self-harm or suicide. The first part is the Support and Safety Plan (SASP) (implemented November 2020) which includes a guided interview with a resident and assists staff to consider other information available. This is completed with all residents and reviewed throughout their placement. The second part, CARE (Collaborative Approach to Risk and Emotion) is a framework for residents identified at an imminent risk of self-harm/suicide. This is a multi-agency approach to managing the risk co-ordinated by the AP Manager (or Duty Manager) which is more direct in managing the immanency e.g., setting levels of welfare checks (including meaningful conversations) removing objects that can cause harm. An audit to assess implementation of this process was conducted in September 2021 and recommendations are in the process of being embedded with oversight of regional Heads of Public Protection.
