1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that COVID-19 positive prisoners receive a daily welfare check and that this is recorded in their medical records.	Accepted	<p>A local operating process (LOP) is in place to ensure assessment occurs for all patients who test positive with Covid-19.</p> <p>The LOP is used to determine what action a healthcare professional must take to monitor a positive prisoner. This assessment is based on risk factors and age of the prisoner. A care plan is then applied to the Covid-19 positive prisoner's record, that denotes the level of monitoring and observations required. This is clearly denoted in S1 medical records.</p> <p>A separate spreadsheet is also used to track and rate a patient's risk of deterioration and forms part of compliance with the LOP.</p>	<p>Complete</p> <p>Head of Healthcare</p>
2	The Governor should ensure that, in line with national policy, staff notify a Prisoner's next of kin as soon as possible when a prisoner becomes seriously ill.	Accepted	Guidance, that a prisoner's next of kin should be informed immediately if a prisoner becomes seriously ill, was emailed to all Custodial Managers and Governor grades responsible for authorising escorts.
