Accepted	<p>All prisoners with a long-term health condition are identified during the initial reception screening process.</p> <p>These prisoners are then booked into the necessary long term condition clinic where clinically relevant assessments and investigations are conducted compliant with NICE guidance including individualised patient care plans. Recalls are set in place on S1 to ensure follow up according to clinical need. This process is monitored via QOF 'How am I driving' on a monthly basis to ensure compliance.</p> <p>The above processes were confirmed and reiterated to staff in June 2021.</p>	<p>Complete</p> <p>Head of Healthcare</p>
2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that all prisoners with conditions identified by the Government as increasing their risk of serious illness as a result of contracting COVID-19 are informed of this and their options regarding shielding and that this is evidenced in their medical record.	Accepted	<p>All prisoners with conditions identified by the Government at increased risk of serious illness as a result of contracting Covid-19 are notified of this risk by healthcare including options re: shielding.</p> <p>This is then documented in the patients S1 medical record.</p> <p>Should the prisoner decline to shield contrary to medical advice a disclaimer is signed to this effect and scanned onto the patient S1 record.</p> <p>The above processes were confirmed and reiterated to staff in June 2021.</p>	<p>Complete</p> <p>Head of Healthcare</p>
