1	The Governor should ensure that all staff are made aware of and understand their responsibilities during medical emergencies in line with Prison Service Instruction (PSI) 03/2013. In particular, where there are serious concerns about the health of a prisoner, staff should use an emergency code immediately to alert control room staff to call an ambulance immediately.	Accepted	<p>Colleagues are consistently reminded that in the unfortunate event that they find a prisoner who is not responsive then they are to call code blue or a code red, for example, colleagues have been issued with emergency response codes prompt cards to remind them of actions to take in the event of a code red/code blue emergency.</p> <p>A notice to colleagues is also published on a monthly basis to this effect.</p> <p>A recent event was held in November 2021 to promote the safety team to colleagues as well as focussing on safety related topics. This included information packs which contained information on what to do in a medical emergency, with bespoke laminates created for Duty Mangers.</p>	Head of Residence and Safety	Complete
