1	<p>The Head of Healthcare should ensure that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> healthcare staff formally assess and record the mental capacity of prisoners who refuse care against medical advice and repeat capacity assessments regularly to ensure that their wishes have not changed; when a best interest decision is required, an appropriate multi-disciplinary meeting is held promptly and accurately recorded; and healthcare staff treat capacity assessments as a priority when the patient's physical health is declining and/or a capacity 	Accepted	<p>Staff have received training regarding those that refuse treatment and in addition we request that patients sign refusal or disclaimer forms. Capacity training has been given and staff understand this can be reviewed at any point and should be undertaken regularly.</p> <p>Best interest meetings are held via Teams to enable community parties/family members to input into someone's care. These are minuted by admin support and then scanned onto S1 notes. 3	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that where there is a do not attempt resuscitation order in place, any requests to review this must be urgently considered and clearly recorded, including when a prisoner wishes to either give or withdraw their consent for the order.	Accepted	All DNAR's have a review date to ensure the patient has the opportunity to review with the relevant clinician. Staff have received training regarding how DNAR's are managed.
