

# Action Plan in response to the PPO Report into the death of Mr Jason Shreeve on 21/02/2021 at HMP Doncaster

1	<p>The Director should ensure that prison staff manage prisoners at risk of suicide or self-harm in line with national guidelines, including by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ensuring that sufficient consideration and weight is given at ACCT case reviews to a prisoner's risk factors for suicide and self-harm; and</li> <li>• ensuring that a prisoner's level of observations appropriately reflect their risk.</li> </ul>	Accepted	<p>ACCT case management at HMP Doncaster is now undertaken by a smaller dedicated group of staff. This has resulted in a more consistent approach being taken to the consideration of risk and allowed staff to form better relationships with those prisoners subject to ACCT monitoring. It has also meant that training can be more easily targeted at case managers in relation to both static and dynamic risk factors.</p> <p>In addition, the introduction of ACCT version 6 across the prison estate is now complete. This provides a better framework for supporting those at risk of self-harm through a more tailored and multi-disciplinary support model that focuses on the needs of the individual. ACCT version 6 also encourages a review of all documentation in relation to risk and protective factors, to discourage staff from an over reliance on a prisoner's presentation, ensuring that levels of risk and observations are appropriately assessed.</p>	Head of Safer Custody Serco	Completed



2	The Director should ensure that, subject to a personal risk assessment, staff go into cells as quickly as possible if there is reason to consider that the prisoner's life may be at risk, in line with national and local policy.	Accepted	<p>Following receipt on this report staff were re-issued with a letter originally sent in October 2020, regarding the procedures that must be followed in the event of a medical emergency during patrol state, including the importance of entering a cell as quickly as possible subject to a personal risk assessment. Pocket cards have also been issued and regular training provided to ensure that staff are aware of and are following the correct procedures.</p> <p>All staff have night packs which have a cell key to enable entry into the cells in emergency situations.</p>	Head of Residence Serco	Completed
