1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that prisoners who are assessed as being in danger of opioid overdose are provided with naloxone training and given a naloxone kit when they leave prison.	Accepted	A full review of the process/pathway of Take Home Naloxone (THN) has taken place with support from the Substance Misuse Clinical Lead and Head of Medicine Management. A new robust process is now in place ahead of the release of patients under the care of the substance misuse service. An opt out process regarding Naloxone training has been introduced and those highlighted as being imminent for release are issued with THN kits. This is monitored closely and data is now collected to assure those eligible are being issued with a THN kit at the point of leaving prison.	Head of Healthcare G4S	Completed
