1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that healthcare staff obtain community medical records for newly arrived prisoners, in line with PSO 3050.	Accepted	SystemOne nationally has been updated to link with patient community records. Elmley has undergone a transition to allow a GP2GP take over. This means that when prisoners arrive to Elmley they can opt to register with our GPs, this will allow access to their full community records. If they decline, staff are still able to access their Summary Care record online which will inform them of past diagnosis and medication prescriptions. 3	The Head of Healthcare should review the basic processes around checking pulses to ensure that staff are able to detect signs of asymptomatic atrial fibrillation (irregular heartbeats) and escalate care accordingly.
