Accepted	Staff have been reminded of importance of completing falls risk assessment and documenting this. This will remain as an agenda item on the full staff meeting for 3 months to reach all staff. A falls flowchart will be created and displayed in the staff room, to remind staff of the actions to take when a patient has fallen.	Head of Healthcare	August 2022
3	The Head of Healthcare should consider the use of the multifactorial falls risk assessment (CG161) for when a person presents with multiple	Accepted	The current falls risk assessment will be reviewed with the clinical governance group to consider any changes that would improve the quality of assessment.
