1	The Governor should ensure that in line with Prison Service Instruction 75/2011 and local instructions on roll checks, four roll checks are carried out each day.	ACCEPTED	<p>A MDT (Multi-Disciplinary Team) meeting has been arranged to review roll check procedures at HMP Wayland. This meeting will be chaired by the Head of Safer Prisons and Head of Security. This meeting will be minuted and any arising actions sent to the Governor for review and approval.</p> <p>The team will review current practices and assure they are compliant to PSI and local instructions (Local Security Strategy LSS). If required these may be amended to ensure they can be safely carried out in all circumstances.</p> <p>Any new actions arising will be communicated to all prison staff.</p> <p>LSS instructions referring to roll checks will be communicated to staff on a regular basis. Welfare checks will be reviewed at the same time as roll checks and greater emphasis will apply to assuring the safety of the prisoner during checks rather than just his presence.</p>	HEAD OF SECURITY & HEAD OF SAFER PRISONS	01/07/2022



2	The Governor should ensure that staff understand the importance of calling the correct medical emergency code promptly.	ACCEPTED	<p>Response codes are regularly advertised and communicated to staff via a number of platforms, including Quarterly Information Notices, Safety Portal, Quarterly establishment emails and daily/weekly/monthly briefings.</p> <p>These information notices are supported and checked prior to issue by the Head of HCC.</p> <p>Mini prompt cards/notices are issued to staff regularly via the Safer Prisons function as a reminder.</p> <p>New actions will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Information Notices to be issued bi-monthly rather than quarterly; • Increased awareness to be issued via Safer Prisons communication strategy 'Safety Portal'; and • New bi-monthly notices will include not only 'Medical Response Code', they will also include a 'Guidance on when not to perform CPR' notice and issued with NOMS, Royal College of Nursing and General Practitioners' approval; • Information to staff on 'Entering Cells in an Emergency' will also be issued; and • New staff will receive this advice during their induction programme with Safer Prisons team.
