Accepted	Notice to Staff to be published in regards to resuscitation when a prisoner presents rigor mortis, highlighting distress for staff and decency for the prisoner. It has also been recognised that there have been previous recommendations in relation to CPR, namely correct positioning. The current recommendation will focus specifically on rigor mortis, so whilst the topic of CPR is similar the specifics are different.
