Accepted	<p>The Offender Manager and Safer Custody Team have reviewed the process of sharing risk-based information to ensure that it is shared with the Community Offender Manager (COM) prior to release. A written record of the any risk information will be used from October 2022 to ensure that all information is documented.</p> <p>All risk-based information relating to suicide and self-harm is discussed at the weekly safety intervention meeting (SIM), the monthly safety meeting and the monthly inter-departmental risk management meeting. 2	The Local Delivery Unit manager of Brighton and Hove probation should ensure that offender managers clearly record in nDelius decisions about sentence plan objectives relating to licence conditions. 		<p>The Senior Probation Officers (SPOs) also discussed this communication to staff in team meetings, explaining requirements to record decision to sequence interventions specified within licence conditions.</p> <p>In order to measure progress, the East Sussex PDU Head (or an appropriate delegate) will complete a dip sample of 20 licence cases within the PDU, to evidence sufficient recording of decisions relating to sequencing of interventions linked to licence conditions by January 2023.</p> <p>If there is evidence of on-going gaps in recording, Head of East Sussex PDU will consider and implement further communications and support to improve this practice moving forward.</p>		January 2023
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
