<p>The Ashley House Management Committee should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> remind staff that they need to consider a resident's current risk factors when assessing his risk to himself and should not rely solely on what he says, how he presents or on his behaviour in the past ensure that staff receive refresher training in risk assessment and management. 	Local	APM / APAM	Accepted	<p>Ashley House have received refresher training relating to the SEEDS model for Supervision and Keywork with residents. The Approved Premise Manager is completing weekly samples of cases ensuring consistency across the team in relation to assessing the risk of harm residents present to themselves. This is resulting in learning that is shared with the team. Keyworkers at Ashley House are completing pre-arrival risk assessments, information from which is shared across the team to ensure previous behaviour and risk factors are fully accounted for prior to arrival and feed into the risk assessment on arrival. The APM is also commencing of meeting with keyworkers looking at current residents' risk to self level to ensure this area of work maintains a high focus.</p> <p>The above has been with a view to creating a culture of assessing residents on an ongoing basis.</p> <p>The APM is in the process of ensuring all staff at Ashley House re-visit SaSP/CARE training on an annual basis and make Suicide/self-harm a regular feature of supervision and team meetings to develop understanding.</p>	December 2021
<p>The National Approved Premises Team should ensure that anyone who is not a direct employee but who regularly works in an AP and has contact with residents, should be made aware of what they should do if they discover a resident has self-harmed, or in other circumstances where risk is raised.</p>	National	NAPT	Accepted	<p>Mandatory information is available to all visitors in AP at the point of signing in. This details such information as security and fire arrangements.
