2	The Governor and the Head of Healthcare should ensure that there is a stroke recognition tool such as FAST (Face Arm Speech Time) in place, in line with NICE guidance for stroke and transient ischaemic attack: diagnosis and initial management (NG128), and ensure that Mandatory First Aid training is up to date for prison and response staff.	Accepted	<p>Notice to Staff was published in June 2022 that highlights the signs of a stroke and immediate care giving instruction if a person is suspected to of suffered a stroke. This will be highlighted in briefings and posters displayed around the units.</p> <p>First Aid Assessment of need was completed on 21/06/2022 with relevant stakeholders. First aiders are to be identified on InVision (our shift centre) as the first aid responder for that shift. Custodial Managers are trained in the first aid at work course and Operational Support Grades are trained in emergency first aid at work. 3	The Governor should ensure that all evidence relevant to a death in custody is completed and retained and that evidence is made available to the PPO, in line with PSI 58/2010.	Accepted	As part of the 24 hour/72 hour Custodial Manager's checks and Governor's 7 days check, this has been added onto the Management Checklist to ask the bedwatch staff if a signed risk assessment is in their possession (5 July 2022). This ensures that if an escort has to leave quickly for preservation of life it is picked up at the earliest opportunity and that a signed risk assessment is completed.	Head of Security	Complete
