1	<p>The Head of Healthcare should ensure that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> prisoners are assessed correctly during their reception screening; and prisoners identified as having mental health issues are referred to the mental health team for assessment. 	Accepted	<p>A Nurse is based in reception from 07:00 to 20:00 Monday to Saturday. A Reception Manager has been recruited and is now in post.</p> <p>All registered Nurses are undertaking a period in reception to ensure they are all competent and confident to complete Reception screening. This will ensure continuity and correct processes are followed, including onward referrals and escalation of risk/concerns.</p> <p>All patients received into HMP Doncaster receive an initial health screen at point of admission. The health screen includes a comprehensive Mental Health history assessment. This assessment provides the clinician a clear guide to appropriate signposting and immediate action required for any patients with mental health or self-harm presentations. The tasks are viewed the following morning as a desk top triage by a Senior Mental health clinician to ensure the patients receive a primary care assessment at the earliest opportunity.</p> <p>Health in Justice Performance targets measure the expected timeframe for mental health assessments. Should this time frame be breached exception reports must be provided to NHS England to account for any breaches, action plans and improvement in performance are implemented to assure Commissioners the patients receive care in a timely manner.</p>		
2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that all prisoners suffering from unexplained first seizures are referred for further investigation, initially to the prison GP, in line with NICE guidance 137: <i>Epilepsies: diagnosis and management</i> .	Accepted	<p>All staff were made aware that prisoners suffering from unexplained first seizures are referred to the GP or ANP as per NICE guidance 137 (August 2021).</p> <p>This will be captured at daily handovers and reflective practice.</p>	Head of Healthcare/GP Clinical Lead	Complete

Accepted	<p>As confirmed in the PPO report the Director issued a Director's Order on 4 February 2021. The Order reminded staff of the times that roll count checks are required and that staff should check on prisoners' welfare when conducting roll count checks.</p> <p>It also introduced two additional welfare checks in the core day and a new requirement that staff make an entry in the Houseblock Assurance Book to confirm that the checks have been completed.</p> <p>Managers are now required to check the Assurance Book regularly.</p>	Director	Complete
