1	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that all staff undertaking risk assessments for prisoners taken to hospital understand the legal position on the use of restraints and that assessments fully take into account the health of a prisoner and are based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time.	Accepted	Information will be published relating to the considerations regarding the use of restraints and the need to ensure these are based on the actual risk posed by the prisoner at that time, referencing Graham vs Secretary of State for Justice 2007. This will be issued to all Governors, Custodial Managers and healthcare staff who are involved in the risk assessment and decision making regarding the application of restraints for any escort. 2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that healthcare staff complete the medical section of the escort risk assessment fully and accurately.	Accepted	The Head of Healthcare will issue a memo reminding staff that the medical section on escort risk assessments must be completed fully and accurately. A dip test of records in 3 months (February) and 6 months (May) time will ensure resolution.	Head of Healthcare Practice Plus Group (PPG)	December 2021
3	The Governor should share this report with the two managers who authorised the use of restraints and discuss the Ombudsman's findings with them.	Accepted	The report will be shared with the named members of staff. All recommendations from PPO Reports are shared with Governors, Managers and all operational staff so that lessons learnt can lead to changes that improve the care and welfare of all prisoners in our charge.
