1	The Governor should ensure that appropriate PPE is available and used by prison staff who may be required to carry out chest compressions on prisoners.	Accepted	<p>There is a standard operating procedure version 6 in place. This describes the PPE requirement for staff requiring to be involved in CPR. All units are responsible to have grab bags of PPE on their units and their unit managers to provide assurance they have them in place. It is the responsible of the unit managers to replenish any PPE. Replacement PPE is freely available for them to collect through the prison stores daily and at the weekends via the Orderly Officer.</p> <p>Grab bag contents</p> <p>PPE for dealing with Suspected/Confirmed Casualties:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Surgical Mask (may be used as a further barrier between patient & staff member if cloth / Towel not available) 2. Nitrile Gloves 3. Apron 4. Eye Protection – Visor/Goggles/Eye glasses 5. FFP Model masks for the use of staff carrying out CPR <p>Additional Equipment held on the wing:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. First Aid Box 2.
