1	The Governor should ensure that authorising managers understand the legal position on the use of restraints and that assessments fully take into account the health of a prisoner and are based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time.	Accepted	All Operational Managers were sent the guidance for Use of Restraints (30.12.2022) during escorts to hospital and the PSI 33/2015 - escorting prisoners outside the prison. This has been replaced by the recently published Prevention of Escape – External escorts guidance (circulated 09.01.2023 to all SMT). This includes ensuring the medical need and mobility of the prisoner is considered as part of the establishments risk assessment process as well as the need for a fresh risk assessment to be conducted each time a seriously or terminally ill prisoner is moved, or their clinical condition is reviews to assess the appropriate level of restraint. 2	The Governor should ensure that all evidence relevant to a death in custody is retained and that evidence is made available to the PPO, in line with PSI 58/2010.	Accepted	All operational Managers and the Head of Safer Custody have been reminded of the requirements (30.12.2022) to ensure all paperwork relevant to a Death in Custody is retained and that evidence is made available in line with PSI 58/2010. This recommendation was specific to Family Liaison Officer (FLO) paperwork and so this has been communicated to the FLO group via the FLO meeting (09.01.2023 and will be minuted on FLO meeting on 13.01.2023).
