Accepted	<p>1. The Head of Healthcare will review the current risk assessments that the nursing team are required to complete to determine the learning that is required.</p> <p>2. The Head of Healthcare will read and familiarise themselves with the most recently published HMPPS Policy - Prevention of Escape - External Escorts (published 8th September 2022)</p> <p>3. The Head of Healthcare will ensure that teaching sessions can be provided for all staff required to complete an escort risk assessment to demonstrate their competence.</p> <p>4. The Head of Healthcare devised and shared guidance with healthcare staff. The guidance directs healthcare staff contributing to risk escorts to provide information relating to the prisoner's mobility, physical ability, reliance on medication and any impairments.
