1	<p>The Head of Healthcare, the healthcare Commissioners and the Governor should review mental health care provision at HMP Leeds. The review should address the prison's capacity to deliver mental health assessments and ongoing interventions effectively, and its ability to support the ACCT process.</p>		<p>The Head of Healthcare has commissioned a joint review of mental health care provision at HMP Leeds. This review, which commenced in June 2018, is being undertaken, by Care UK, HMPPS and NHS commissioning. It is due to be finalised by the end of August 18. The scope of the review includes the prison's capacity to delivery mental health assessments and ongoing interventions effectively and its ability to support the ACCT process. The findings from this review will be used to revise systems and improve the overall delivery of mental health services at the prison.</p> <p>A review of the triage process has already taken place to ensure all prisoners are triage assessed within five days for routine referrals and 24 hours for urgent referrals. This is recorded on a referral tracker to monitor compliance. Following a daily triage clinic, each complex patient is now discussed at a mental health multi-disciplinary meeting.</p>	<p>Head of Healthcare September 2018</p>
