1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that all prisoners requesting a DNACPR order are assessed, preferably face-to-face, to establish if they are at risk of suicide, that they have mental capacity, and that no mental health issues are apparent.	Accepted	<p>All applications from prisoners requesting a DNACPR are now seen face to face by the GP and Head of Healthcare to discuss the process. The prisoner's understanding is checked and mental capacity is documented. The appropriate form is signed by both medical staff and the original copy is given to the prisoner to keep. Copies of the form are held in Healthcare in a DNAR file with copies placed in the emergency code red and blue bag. Further copies are shared with wing Custodial Managers, wing staff, and the Safer Custody team.</p> <p>Prisoners who possess a DNAR are discussed monthly in the short life span meeting in Healthcare and this is also a weekly agenda item at the Safer Custody meeting.</p>	Head of Healthcare December 2020
2	<p>The Head of Healthcare should ensure that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Staff provide a full and accurate record of the DNACPR assessment in the prisoner's medical record, including details of all staff who have provided input and the rationale behind the decision; and •All correspondence received from the prisoner, or from anywhere else, relating to the DNACPR order is immediately scanned and retained on the prisoner's medical record. 	Accepted	<p>DNACPR assessments are carried out and documented by the GP following discussion with the Head of Healthcare and Practice Nurse in a multidisciplinary short life span meeting which takes place monthly. Following placement of DNACPR requests the Safer Custody team are now informed so that this can be discussed at the weekly multidisciplinary safety meeting where DNARs are an agenda item. A decision is also made to appoint a Family Liaison Officer if appropriate.</p> <p>Information about the prisoner's future wishes surrounding DNACPR is shared with appropriate members of healthcare and operational staff and relevant documentation is now scanned onto the prisoner's SystemOne care records. This is reviewed by the Practice Nurse as part of the monthly audit performance.</p>	Head of Healthcare December 2020
