1	<p>The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that staff understand the legal position on the use of restraints and that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Healthcare staff complete the medical section of the escort risk assessment fully and accurately so that it is clear whether the prisoner's health and/or mobility affect their ability to escape;</li> <li>Authorising managers consider the healthcare input to the escort risk assessment and record that they have done so; and</li> <li>Authorising managers note whether the prisoner is on the 'no cuffing list' and if restraints are authorised, record the full reasoning.</li> </ul>	Accepted	<p>Healthcare will endeavour to ensure that the medical risk assessment section is completed with accurate and up to date information of the prisoner's health and mobility.</p> <p>A new section on the Escort Risk Assessment has been added specifically for the consideration of the health care risk assessment.
