1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that second stage health assessments are undertaken in line with NG57 guidance.	Accepted	All second stage health assessments are now completed within the NG57 guidance, not on the same day and within a 7-day arrival period. New 2nd screen receptions ledgers have been created and patients are populated onto these ledgers – staff are detailed daily to complete these screenings. A reminder to staff has completed during daily handovers.	Head of Healthcare	Completed
2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that blood sugars are taken as baseline at reception/second health screening for those patients with type 1 or type 2 diabetes.	Accepted	Baseline readings should be taken on all diabetic patients in reception. Staff have been reminded via handover meetings and it will be included in the full staff meeting for the next 3 months.	Head of Healthcare	July 23



3	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that there is a robust process in place for receipt of information into the kitchens for prisoners' medical diets (for example diabetic diets).	Accepted	A meeting will take place with the Catering Manager and Head of Healthcare to review and agree a process to be implemented that will ensure that regular information is shared between the Kitchen and Healthcare regarding patients who have medical dietary requirements. The process will include a pathway email trail for new receptions/diagnosis of medical conditions relating to diet etc. The implementation meeting is planned for week commencing 15th May 2023.
