Weight should be taken and recorded as prompted within the reception screening template; this is not currently a mandatory field.</p> <p>Request made to clinical systems team to make weight a mandatory field within the reception screening template to ensure this cannot be missed when completing the reception screening in future.</p> <p>Learning to be shared with the healthcare team to ensure a baseline weight is captured at point of reception.</p>	Head of Healthcare	31/12/2022
2	The Head of Healthcare and the Primary Care Lead should ensure that screening related to the Bowel Screening Programme is recorded in line with National Prevention Compliance guidance.	Accepted	Bowel screening is undertaken by the NHS national screening programme. Meeting arranged to develop a local standard operating procedure around recording of issuing and return of kits. Along with the recording of unreturned kits and ensuring a make every contact conversation is documented to understand the reasoning for non-engagement with the programme and reoffer at the recommended intervals.
