In order to achieve this, we will:

- Ensure that all staff read and understand their roles/responsibilities in the Prevention of Escape – External Escorts Policy.
- Ensure all Custodial Manager’s and Governors involved in Risk assessment process, read and understand the Prevention of Escape – External Escorts Policy. Highlighting 4.156 “Serious/Terminal Illness” when assessing the need for restraints.
- Ensure that all Bedwatch staff are aware of their responsibilities to communicate any “Sudden deterioration or improvement of health requiring
