Accepted	<p>The learning from this death was discussed at the full staff meeting held on the 30th July 2022. The minutes of this meeting were then sent to all staff on the 8th August 2022, including staff who could not attend the meeting.</p> <p>The Head of Healthcare has sent an email out to the entire healthcare team with an acknowledgement voting button attached to ensure all staff are fully aware of the differences between DNA CPR end of life pathway and DNA CPR active treatment pathway.
