1	The Governor should ensure that prison staff understand when to use medical emergency codes, in line with Prison Service Instruction (PSI) 03/2013.	Accepted	Medical emergency codes notices are shared with staff twice a year. In addition we have a member of the safety team hand deliver them to staff as they enter the establishment each year to ensure they get a copy and understand the importance of familiarising themselves with the actions they need to take. This is ongoing and will be completed every year. Additionally, all staff coming through the induction process are also briefed by the induction Senior Officer. To ensure staff have a permanent reminder we issue emergency response in custody cards (ERIC) which staff keep with their ID card which is a quick guide as to what to do. 3	The Governor should ensure that all evidence about a death in custody, including statements and electronic evidence, is retained and promptly made available to the Prisons and Probation Ombudsman, in line with PSI 58/2010.	Accepted	Safer custody have a process in place to ensure all evidence is retained for PPO / Coroner inquests and this is retained locally in line with PSI 58/2010. We have introduced a checklist to ensure all documents are collected, retained and forwarded where required.
