2	The Governor should initiate an investigation into OSG A's actions on the night of 14/15 August with a view to considering if further action is appropriate.	Accepted	A review of OSG A's actions on the night 14/15 August will be undertaken (on 30 May 2021) by the Deputy Governor and appropriate action will be taken.	Complete  Deputy Governor
3	The Governor should ensure that staff understand the circumstances in which they should call a medical emergency code (in line with Prison Service Instruction 03/2013).	Accepted	A Notice To Staff was re-issued in May 2021. Additionally, all staff are issued with a medical response code cards.  The safety department have introduced quarterly assurance checks on staff understanding of when to call a code blue or red emergency.	Complete  Head of Res & Safety
4	The Governor should ensure that staff responsible for calling an ambulance must call an ambulance as soon as an emergency medical code is called.	Accepted	The Notice To Staff 51.20 contains staff responsibility to call an ambulance immediately. The Notice was re-issued to staff in May 2021.  Medical Emergency Response Code cards are given to all staff including new members of staff.	Complete  Head of Res & Safety

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5	The Governor of North Sea Camp should ensure that the minimum level of first aid trained staff is adhered to at all times.	Accepted	There is now a minimum of 1 member of staff of first aid trained during the night. This figure rises during the core day.	Complete  People Hub
6	The Governor should develop a service level agreement with East Midlands Ambulance Service to ensure that prisoners receive equivalent access to urgent care in a medical emergency.	Accepted	A Service Level Agreement (SLA) with East Midlands Ambulance Service is in place and was last reviewed in August 2020. The SLA will be updated by 1 October 2021 to include the use of the Air Ambulance.	Complete  Healthcare
7	The Governor of North Sea Camp should ensure that all staff involved in a serious incident are invited to a debrief.	Accepted	A debrief was completed on 19/08/20 and a further debrief was held on 24/08/20.
