1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that a clear plan for all long-term conditions is documented, including the need for appropriate monitoring to ensure safe prescribing.	Accepted	The pandemic has caused some disruption to this service. A review was scheduled for July 2020, however due to the pandemic COVID-19 we reduced the number of face to face to minimise the risks of transmission. The local laboratories had advised to only send urgent bloods at this time. We have now re-commenced all routine medication reviews (from April 2021) and are carrying out routine blood tests. 2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that medication is not prescribed without proper assessment and full consideration of risks and alternatives.	Accepted	As we are no longer an outbreak site from April 2021 we are increasing the number of face to face appointments. The physio is now on site conducting assessments.  Medication is only initiated following a full assessment, prescribers have been reminded of the importance of documenting their consideration of risks and alternatives.	Complete  Head of Healthcare
3	The Head of Healthcare should discuss the clinical reviewer's findings with the healthcare team, including GPs.	Accepted	The report was shared with the team including the GP's in April 2021. A meeting was held to discuss the findings of the clinical reviewer.	Complete  Head of Healthcare
