1	The Head of Healthcare must ensure all clinical staff understand the national guidance for the management of diabetes.	Accepted	All staff are going to receive training in the management of Diabetes. The Clinical lead and long term conditions nurse will be the first to do the course and then they will share with rest of staff, through a recognised course.	Head of Healthcare	June 2022
2	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that urgent medical appointments are cancelled as a last resort and there is a clear record of the reason for the cancellation.	Accepted	A plan has already been put in place, whereby no patient will have their appointment cancelled unless it has first been triaged by a clinician, preferably a senior one. The process is due to signed off by governance.	Head of Healthcare	March 2022
3	The Governor should ensure that all staff undertaking risk assessments for prisoners in hospital understand the legal position, and that assessments fully take into account the health of the prisoner and are based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time.	Accepted	All risk assessments for hospital appointments include the principles of the Graham Judgement to aid the Duty Director when making decisions for cuffing arrangements. The Duty Director completing daily bedwatch checks will brief the escorting staff to contact the Prison as soon as practicable in the event of any deterioration in the prisoners condition to allow the Duty Director to review the use of restraints if appropriate.
