1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that there is a pre-release care planning process for prisoners known to healthcare which should include actions with timescales and an identified lead, with onwards referrals to community services.	Accepted	A discharge flow coordinator has been appointed to take the lead on pre-release planning and onward support, ensuring that we have effective releases into the community and transition between establishments. This includes, continuity of care through transition and so that when individuals leave prison, their healthcare needs are met by services in the community. 2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that when a prisoner has abnormal test results close to their release date, that these results are passed to their community GP, or given to the prisoner so that they can make an appointment in the community.	Accepted	A process has been introduced whereby an alert for abnormal blood results will appear on System One. The alert will notify the discharge flow coordinator who will as part of the sole duties, inform the prisoners community GP. In the event that the prisoner does not have a GP in the community, they will be provided with a copy of their blood results.	Head of Healthcare (Oxleas NHS Foundation Trust)	Completed
