Accepted	<p>The Head of Healthcare ensures that the Healthcare team, which includes their own Occupational Therapist, carries out falls risk assessments and the management team conduct management checks.</p> <p>The Head of Healthcare ensures that injuries sustained in a fall are checked, recorded and in some cases, photographed so that we have an accurate record and can manage the care and treatment of the patient.</p> <p>The Head of Healthcare ensures that staff conduct a reception screen within the appropriate timeframes. The templates include questions around previous issues and injuries (which may include injuries during their transfer).
