1	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that staff hold an urgent ACCT case review whenever information is received that a prisoner's risk might have increased, in line with the requirements of PSI 64/2011.	Accepted	<p>A Daily Safety Intervention Meeting (SIM) has been established and embedded at HMP Wayland. This is a multi-disciplinary team meeting where all prisoners who may pose or be at risk of suicide or self-harm are discussed. A member of healthcare, or the mental health team attend every SIM meeting.</p> <p>Any new or emerging information received around risk is discussed during the SIM and, when necessary, an urgent ACCT case review will be conducted.</p> <p>The healthcare team will contact wing managers and the duty Orderly Officer whenever information is received that a prisoner's risk might have increased due to healthcare issues, such as medication reviews, and which require urgent action to allow for an ACCT case review to be conducted immediately.</p> <p>ACCT training provides guidance on the effective management of the ACCT process and is delivered to all new staff and as refresher training.
