1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that end-of-life care planning is held with terminally ill prisoners, including discussing DNACPR, and involving family members, where relevant.	Accepted	Head of healthcare to initiate a full multidisciplinary meeting to include prison staff and family members should a patient become in the last stages of life. This will include the do not attempt rustication status of the patient.	Spectrum Community Health CIC	Completed
2	The Governor should review the family liaison process and assure themselves that when a prisoner becomes seriously or terminally ill, timely arrangements are made for a family liaison officer to be appointed, who will initiate contact with their next of kin.	Accepted	We now have an assigned senior manager SPOC for all FLOs. Once a prisoner becomes seriously/terminally ill and is located in either inpatients or attends outside hospital a FLO will be appointed with support from the SPOC. Next of kin data is shared with the residential and safer custody teams from new receptions to identify any prisoners with missing next of kin information.
